

# LEARNING MORE ABOUT THE SCHOOL DRESS CODE

Jackson Middle School follows Orange County Public Schools Dress Code Policy.

Deans, teachers and staff members will do dress code checks throughout the day and year.

- The deans will have teachers send students that are out of dress code to the grade level office.
- 1<sup>st</sup> offense – warning, phone call home and **must change into appropriate clothing.**
- 2<sup>nd</sup> offense – Wednesday school, phone call home and **must change into appropriate clothing.**
- 3<sup>rd</sup> and multiple offenses – Saturday school, phone call home and **must change into appropriate clothing.**

Parents will be called to bring in a change of clothing

- If no one can be contacted, student will exchange their clothes for the appropriate clothes the school can provide.
- Students will get their clothing returned once they return to school with the school provided clothing laundered.

Shirts	Pants/Shorts	Shorts
Straps must be 4 fingers wide No lace/see through No lace on just the back of the shirt No holes in the shoulders No holes in the shirts	If underwear is showing, zip ties will be provided to hold pants up Holes in pants cannot be above the fingertip line Leggings/Stockings/Jeggings are not allowed UNLESS they are UNDER a skirt, dress, or shorts Shorts cannot be shorter than the finger tip line	No Slides, bedroom slippers or flip flops
